Tsang has made a major impact on Santa Monica College, bringing fiscal stability to the institution; fostering cordial relations among all constituencies at the college; establishing an open and inclusive management style; and building excellent relations with Santa Monica City Hall, the Santa Monica-Malibu Unified School District and other local and regional organizations. Active in the community, he serves on the Santa Monica Chamber of Commerce Board and The Madison Project Board (a nonprofit serving the SMC Performing Arts Center), among others, and has been a speaker at the UCLA Anderson School of Management and the USC Rossier School of Education.

He is currently proposing a SMC Municipal Bond issuance of \$295 million to rebuild outdated buildings that serve math, science and nursing students and a Center in Malibu among other projects.
