Val Zavala has been the anchor of SoCal Connected since its debut in 2008. Ms. Zavala also serves as KCET's Vice President of News and Public Affairs. Prior to SoCal Connected, Ms. Zavala was anchor and producer of KCET's award-winning weekday news program Life & Times.

During her career at KCET she has won 16 L.A. Area Emmy® Awards and 8 Golden Mikes. In 2006 Ms. Zavala was honored by Hispanic Americans for Fairness in Media and named one of the one hundred most influential Latinos by Hispanic Business magazine.

Prior to joining KCET in 1987, Ms. Zavala spent six years reporting at commercial news stations. Ms. Zavala is a trustee of Mt. Saint Mary's College from which she received an honorary doctorate. She attended Stanford University in 1992 on a John S. Knight Journalism Fellowship. She received her Masters in journalism from American University in Washington, D. C. and her B.A. in Latin American Studies from Yale University.
